

During Open House session, anyone can write any question relevant to dermatology and send to experts group on stage, who will answer anything they choose. If they pass, anyone from audience can choose to answer.

10 KA DUM:



1. Topical steroid damaged face and groin: Steroid induced rosacea with papules, pustules and worried about sensitive skin. How to stop/taper steroid, role of tacro/pimecro and tackling the withdrawal. Management options for sensitive skin, Brominidine, Ivermectin etc.
2. Dermatophyte infection : persistent and recurrent among members of the same family. Treatment options, economic considerations, sweating and humidity factors, drug resistance, drug discussion from Griseofulvin to Voriconazole and amphotericin B
3. Recurrent pyoderma and scalp folliculitis: Role of antibiotics to isotretinoin. Role of nasal swab culture, antibiotics: which one and for how long? What are the risks?
4. Chronic hand eczema: role of patch testing, relevance with clinical practice, topical to systemic therapies, barrier creams, PUVASOL, Gloves, Liquid cleansers and their role in eczemas, hand sanitizers, soaps: harsh and mild, role of pH of skin.
5. Severe psoriasis: patient had unmonitored Methotrexate for several years, acetretin not responding, not willing for phototherapy, scared of Cyclosporin. Treatment options Biologics, which one and why? Biosimilars over biologics, when to stop, can you stop, ever?
6. Herpes Zoster: Which drug and for how long, management of neuralgia, vaccine or not, when to refer to ophthal or neurology? HIV positives, cancer patients, renal patients: antiviral doses and adjustments.
7. Rapidly progressing vitiligo: Steroids or not? if yes, for how long, role of azathioprine, ciclosporine, methotrexate, phototherapy for how many sessions, risk for skin cancers, camouflage, costs, expectations, when to wean off systemic therapy once you have started?
8. Parthenium dermatitis : Tips and tricks, azathioprine, methotrexate, intramuscular steroids, patch test, barriers, wet wraps, clothing, work related changes, economic considerations.
9. Palmoplantar Psoriasis vs pustulosis: Managing pain, risk of cellulitis, acetretin, smoking, biologics, phototherapy, occlusion.
10. Oral lichen planus: Options, risks of cancer, when to biopsy, differentials, recurrence and various management options.

How To Hit A Sixer On Dusra: Off label usage of drugs in Dermatology to optimise disease outcome and safeguarding yourself with medico-legal complications.

Yaadon Ki Baarat: Memory based clinical case discussion from the legends on one/few of the most difficult/puzzling cases of their practice.

Blast From The Past: obsolete Molecules, Techniques/Procedures and preparations of practical in day to day practice of dermatology.

Back To Basics :

1. Vaccination in adult and pediatric age group receiving immunotherapy.
2. Work up and Management of the cases with FPHL, PCOS, Insulin Resistance and Acne.
3. Various Pharmacological preparations, differences in vehicles, location of application and indication based usage and choosing the optimal cost effective brand for best clinical outcome.

4. A young champ fond of Thailand trips and body massage having venereophobia.



- 5 Extensive Female pattern hair loss in a 20 year old female with normal hormonal levels,
- 6 Severe acne scars with keloids
- 7 Bilateral Portwine stain with tissue hypertrophy
- 8 patient with eb or lamellar ichthyosis.
- 9 Klippel trenaunay syndrome with scrotal lymphangiectasis.
